Widespread floods across Pakistan have caused unprecedented destruction in several parts of the country. More than 1,000 people are reportedly dead so far and several more are still missing, along with livestock. Crops and family assets have been destroyed. More than 300,000 homes, thousands of schools, health centers, bridges and other infrastructure have been destroyed while almost 40 million people or about a fifth of Pakistan's population have been directly hit by this calamity. Pakistan's flood related challenge is far from over, as a further spell of intense rainfall is expected in September and the hardships caused especially to the vulnerable population groups, are likely to remain for their lifetime.

In response to this emergency, the Madinatul Ilm Charitable Trust (MICT) has launched an emergency appeal to raise Rs.1 crore to provide urgently needed food rations and other essential items to some of the worst hit areas. MICT intends to reach four districts of Pakistan @ Rs 2,500,000 per district. In future phases, MICT will raise additional funds to cover more families and geographical areas. As of now, Swat has been selected in Khyber Pakhtookhwa, Rajanur/Taunsa Shareef in South Punjab and Balochistan (Jaffarabad/Sibi/Bolan to be confirmed) Sindh(Badin/Khairpur/Dadu to be confirmed). Districts will be added, subject to funding.

A food pack for a middle size family of six @Rs 5000 approximately will consist of the following items:

- Rice
- Milk Pack
- Tea
- Sugar
- Daal/Lentils
- Cooking spices
- Flour
- Cooking oil/ghee
- Soap
- Match box
- Chatai/Mat

MICT is also collecting donations in kind, particularly clothes in good condition, shoes, beddings, cooking pots, plates, glasses etc.
