HELPING PEOPLE – CHANGING LIVES

Introduction:

In Pakistan, 44.7% (source; *The World Bank*) of people are living below the poverty line, indicating a profound need for immediate action to help alleviate the situation. While Madinatul Ilm Charitable Trust (MICT) is committed to a variety of avenues for helping those in need, its ultimate objective is to end the suffering of vulnerable population groups. MICT believes that every human being has the right to live a life of self-respect, dignity and economic security.

MICTs objectives are:

- To promote the cause of human welfare through charitable activities, especially in the realm of imparting knowledge and education for the benefit of mankind and humanity in need.
- To cooperate with other like-minded individuals, groups and associations involved in similar undertakings, to foster collective goodwill through mutual cooperation.
- To place special emphasis on the principle of human wellbeing through literacy and educational promotion being the supreme goal for mankind.
- To promote all aspects of human welfare and charity, in all fields through all available means and resources, to intervene in crises-stricken situations, wherever they arise in Pakistan.

OUR WORK AT A GLANCE

Here are the areas and disbursements made by MICT during the financial year 2024-2025:

1. Education Program:

MICT continued its education initiative with the primary aim of offering financial assistance to bright and deserving students irrespective of gender, age, or geographical background. During the reporting period, MICT provided educational support to 12 students, allocating Rs1,566,721 to cover their academic expenses.



2. Health Program:

During the financial year 2024-25, MICT provided assistance to three vulnerable and needy patients, allocating a total of Rs 370,000 for essential treatment and care. In addition, a medical camp was organized in Parachinar where medicines worth Rs 270,757 were sent by MICT. Altogether, the expenditure under health program during this period amounted to Rs 620,757.



3. Water & Sanitation Program:

During the financial year 2024-25, MICT spent a total of Rs 7,714,000 on the installation of 172 hand pumps in water-scarce areas of Jhang, Muzaffargarh, Bahawalnagar, Chiniot, Bhakkar, Bahawalpur, Layyah, Mianwali, Rajan Pur and Charsadda. In addition, MICT established a water filtration plant in DG Khan, with an expenditure of Rs 400,000, to provide safe drinking water to the local community. MICT has installed two electric water coolers in Jhang worth Rs110,000. Altogether, the expenditure under water & sanitation program during this period amounted to Rs 8,224,000.



4. Ramzan Food Program:

Ahead of the holy month of the Ramzan, MICT distributed 635 food packs benefiting nearly 3800 family members in district Muzaffargarh, Layyah, Rawalpindi and Islamabad (ICT). The total expenditure on this initiative amounted to Rs 3,234,661. Through this program, MICT aimed to provide timely relief to vulnerable families facing food insecurity during the fasting month.



5. Capacity Building & Livelihood Program:

In 2024-25, MICT continued its efforts to support underprivileged individuals willing to start small scale businesses for sustainable livelihoods. Goods worth Rs 1,693,000 were provided to 49 beneficiaries, enabling them to generate income for their families.

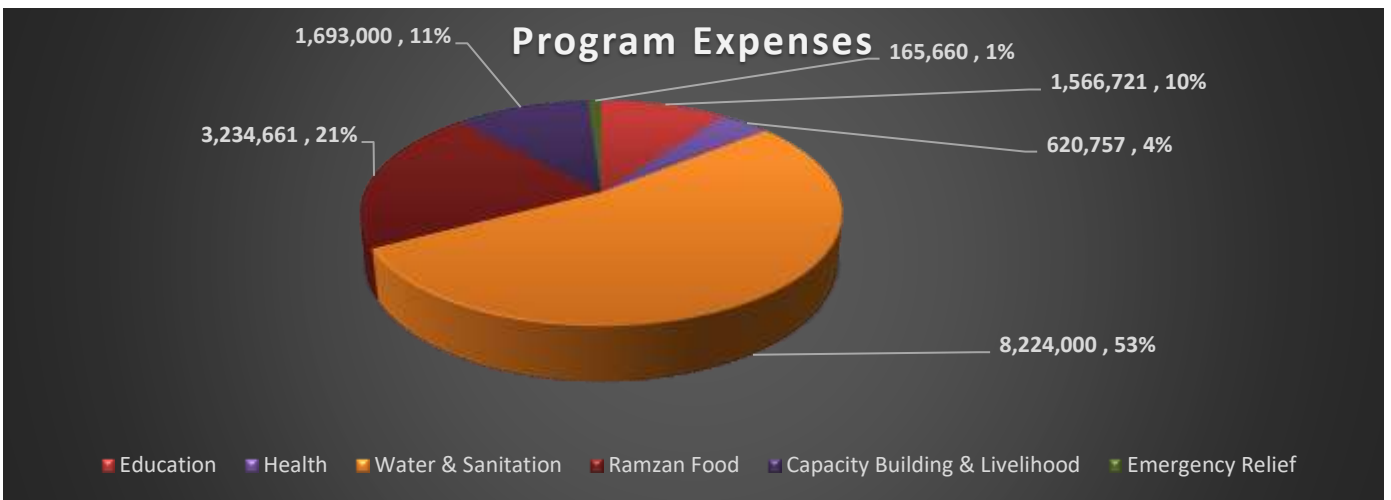


6. Emergency Relief Program:

During the financial year 2024-25, a total of Rs 165,660 was utilized to distribute sweaters and socks amongst 130 needy students of Rawalpindi under the Emergency Relief Program. In addition, donation in kind were also sent to Parachinar. These included clothes, shoes, beddings and other households items.
