### Education and Health Programmes 2025–2026

**Background:**

Madinatul Ilm Charitable Trust (MICT) is a non-profit organization based in Rawalpindi (Pakistan) dedicated to uplifting underprivileged communities through education, health, water and sanitation, emergency relief, livelihood and Ramzan food programmes. Over the years, MICT has extended support to deserving individuals and families through its ongoing welfare programmes.

**Project Title:**

Education and Health Programmes 2025–2026

**Total Budget:**

PKR 7,000,000 (Rs. seventy lakhs)

- **Education Programme:** PKR 4,000,000 (Rs. forty lakhs)
- **Health Programme:** PKR 3,000,000 (Rs. thirty lakhs)

**Project Duration:**

12 Months (July 2025 – June 2026)

**1. Education Programme**

To improve access to education for needy students by providing financial support in the form of scholarships for tuition fees and other educational expenses. Under this program, MICT aims to provide support to deserving students belonging to low-income families based on merit. The assistance includes tuition fees, school/college expenses, and essential educational materials.

**Implementation Method:**

- Funds will be provided directly into the official accounts of institutions. No cash payment will be made in advance to any student.
- Selection will be strictly need-based, verified through supporting documentation. Priority will be given to students demonstrating consistent academic performance and financial hardship. The family income is also considered. Long term goals of older students will be established.

**Expected Outcome:**

- Approximately 25 students supported for one academic year.

**2. Health Programme**

The Health Programme is designed to provide financial assistance for medical treatment, surgeries, diagnostic tests, and hospitalization of deserving patients who cannot afford healthcare costs. Transparent scrutiny of applications is carried out to identify genuine cases.

**Implementation Method:**

- Payments will be made directly to hospitals or healthcare institutions.
- Selection will be need-based, focusing on patients from low-income households with verified medical documentation.

Expected Outcome:

- Financial assistance to support approximately 15 deserving patients.

**Selection Criteria:**

1. Applicant should be from a low-income household. Verified supporting documents will be required such as income certificate if available, educational or medical records etc. Selection will be made purely on need basis, irrespective of gender, religion, or any other forms of discrimination. The quantum of assistance will be decided, as either “full” or “partial” depending on the family’s economic situation.

Through this combined initiative, MICT aims to bring positive changes in the lives of needy and deserving individuals. We appeal to our valued donors and partners to come forward and contribute generously to this noble cause.
