The unprecedented rainfall across Pakistan has led to colossal damages of human life, livestock, livelihood and properties. The already poor and deprived population groups have become even more vulnerable. Unfortunately, the effects of climate change are projected to be an annual phenomenon. The devastating effect of this calamity can be witnessed on the ground where the victims are either left under the open sky, or forced to live in tents or seek refuge with extended families. Their rehabilitation will take time and resources and sadly many of them will never see the light of the day.

Emergency Relief

MICT plans to raise Rs 75 lakhs for providing urgently needed food items to approximately 1500 families. Food packs will be given with slight variation as needed from area to area.

- Turmeric (Powder)
- Cooking oil/ghee
- Garam Misala
- Salt (1 pkt)

Education

Countless schools have been partially or fully damaged. The already low literacy and school attendance rates will fall down further if infrastructure and teaching are not put back in place. MICT has visited a number of damaged schools and five such schools have been identified in Punjab and KPK for rehabilitation so that children can return in safe learning environments.

Livelihood

The scale of the tragedy and its far reaching consequences will pose very long-term challenges for all concerned. The poorer the family, the more the challenges leading to increased vulnerabilities of the already vulnerable, weak and poor. The future looks very bleak and dismal. MICT is planning to support locally relevant livelihood opportunities to men and women in five villages affected by floods.
