## FUNDING APPEAL

### Introduction

As the blessed month of Ramzan 2026 approaches, **Madinatul Ilm Charitable Trust (MICT)** is launching its annual funding appeal of Ramzan Food Programme to support 1000 needy families with essential food supplies. The aim is to help low-income households observe the holy month with dignity and relief from financial hardships.

Over the past months, Pakistan has witnessed heavy rains and devastating floods, causing severe loss of lives, homes, and livestock in many areas. Thousands of families have been left struggling to recover from these disasters. Combined with soaring inflation and rising food prices, many already poor families are now unable to meet their basic food needs.

During this holy month, fasting from dawn to sunset becomes even more challenging for those who cannot afford daily essentials such as flour, rice, lentils, and Banaspati ghee/oil. Through this programme, MICT strives to reach such vulnerable families and provide them with the necessary food support to sustain themselves throughout Ramzan.

MICT's Ramzan Food Programme aims at raising Rs. 55 lakhs to procure and distribute food packs among 1000 poor and needy families. To the extent possible, food packs are purchased at or near the points of distribution, giving business opportunities to local vendors to enhance their income. By so doing, MICT also saves on transportation costs.

The food packs will contain the following tentative items by quantities: -

DATES 400 G	FLOUR – 15 KG	CORRIANDER PWD – 100G
RICE (BASMATI) – 2KG	COOKING OIL – 2 KG	SUGAR – 1 KG
DAAL CHANNA–1 KG	RED CHILLIES – 200 G	TAPAL TEA – 170 G
DAAL MOONG – 1 KG	SALT – 800 G	WHITE CHANA – 1 KG

### Target Groups

MICT will target needy families in vulnerable areas prioritizing widows, orphans, unemployed, laborers and daily wage earners, special people and other disaster-affected households. Data collection is underway to compile details of families in need. MICT staff and volunteers will personally distribute food packs at selected distribution points.

### Estimated Cost

The estimated cost per food pack is Rs.5500 inclusive of procurement, packing and distribution expenses. A total of Rs. 55,00,000 (Fifty-Five Lakh Rupees) is targeted to provide food packs for 1000 families. The number of families will be adjusted if actual prices vary at the time of purchase.
